Royal Canadian Legion, Branch #239 Guidelines for Donations

Statement:

The Royal Canadian Legion, Branch #239 will normally utilize proceeds from their lottery funds to provide donations towards activities that positively benefit youth, seniors and veterans.

Eligibility Criteria:

Local residents and non-profit organizations are eligible to receive donations providing that the donation will benefit youth, seniors and/or veterans. The definition of a youth is a person aged 21 years or less and a senior is a person aged 55 years or older.

Requests for donations to assist with travel or registration costs to attend a function, tournament or event will normally be limited to a maximum of \$2,000.00 per function, tournament or event. If the request is approved, the Branch may request the recipient to provide a detailed trip report upon their return from the function, tournament or event.

Requests to assist with costs associated with attending school are not eligible for funding.

Exemptions:

Donations can be approved towards projects that are sanctioned by the Royal Canadian legion and/or the Canadian Armed Forces even though they may not directly benefit youth, seniors and veterans.

Donations can be approved to Branch Members to assist during a time of need, an emergency or a family crisis.

Donations can be approved to Branch Members up to \$500.00, with receipts, to cover expenses for Legion sporting events (this was a Motion made and approved at the March 16, 2010 General Meeting). That Branch Members requesting money for sports travel attend a total of five (5) Legion activities and/or volunteer activities (this motion was made and approved at the March 20, 2007 General Meeting).

Application Process:

- 1.) Submit an "Application for Donations" form to the President, RCL, Branch 239, Box 280, Fort Smith, NT, X0E 0P0
- 2.) You will be notified to to the eligibility of your request and if eligible you will be requested to present your application at a General Meeting of the membership of the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch #239. General Meetings are held at the Branch every third Tuesday of the month except for the months of July and August. A decision on your request will be made at that meeting.
